Horgabost Wind Turbine

Additional checks are being carried out on the grid voltage and system set-up of the turbine to ensure its safe operation. An update will be given at the board meeting.

Pairc Niseaboist- Community Building

The building is almost complete with workers expected to be out of the building by Christmas. However the late changes to the venting requirements of the kitchen mean that the larger fan will not be ready to install until mid to late January.
